



DATA PRIVACY NOTICE AND AUTHORISATION TO PROCESS

In compliance with Legislative Decree 196 of the 30th June 2003 and relevant annexes thereto, governing the privacy of sensitive personal data belonging to individuals and parties, FLUIDEA hereby declares that it holds and processes all personal data exclusively according to the principles of correctness, legality, transparency, confidentiality and respect for customers' rights.

In particular, in compliance with articles 7 and 13 of the said Legislative Decree:

1. Personal data will be held exclusively for purposes related to the fulfilment of requests and will be processed using computer systems, hard copy and other suitable media, in respect of the requirements of the Technical Regulations on minimum security measures, Annex B of the Unified Privacy Act.

2. The provision of personal data is mandatory. Such data will, however, not be released to third parties or divulged.

3. The data holder and person designated as responsible for its security is Mr. Ulisse Albani.

4. The data owner may exercise his rights in regard of the data holder, as established in Article 7 of the Unified Privacy Act 196/2003, at any time. These rights are reported in full here below.

1) The data owner has the right to obtain confirmation as to whether his personal data is held or not, even if not yet recorded, and has the right to receive a copy of that data in intelligible form.

2) The data owner has the right to be informed of:

- a) the source from which his personal data was obtained;
- b) the purposes for which it is held and the methods applied to processing it;
- c) the logic applied to the processing of his personal data if processed by electronic means;
- d) the identity of the data holder, and that of the person or persons designated responsible for that data under the terms of Article 5, comma 2;
- e) the persons or categories to whom his personal data may be released, or who may come into possession of it as designated local representatives of the State, or as agents or officers of the State.

3) The data owner has the right to:

- a) update, correct, or add to his personal data at any time;
- b) delete, render anonymous, or halt the use of personal data used in violation of the law, including any data that does not need to be held for the purposes for which it was originally collected or subsequently processed;
- c) receive certification that the operations listed under letters a) and b) above have been demanded of all other parties to whom the data has been released or divulged, unless to do so proves impossible or would require disproportionate effort or expenditure.

4) The data owner has the right to halt, in whole or in part:

- a) the use of his personal data, even for the purpose for which it was originally collected, for any valid reason whatsoever;
- b) the holding and processing of his personal data for the purpose of distributing advertising or sales material or for the purpose of market research or sales-related communications.
